The Gift to Be Simple

Folk Melody

Andante moderato

C POSITION

A RONDO has at least 3 sections. The 1st section is repeated after each of the other sections, and there is often a CODA (added ending).

A RONDINO is a miniature RONDO.

In this RONDINO, the 1st and 3rd sections are in the key of C Major. The 2nd section is in G Major.
