To the Teacher:

This book is designed for the elementary to late elementary piano student who, having a good understanding of piano basics, is now ready for music that encompasses a broader range of notes, technique, style and expressiveness. The pieces in *A Pirate's Life* use much more of the keyboard than those at previous levels of study, but do so mostly in the security of easily identifiable five-finger positions. Technical challenges include elementary pedaling, the use of a wide range of dynamics and tempi, occasional legato vs. staccato playing, balance of melody and accompaniment (with some left-hand melody) and hand crossing.

A Pirate's Life gives the student opportunities for playing in a variety of styles and with great expressiveness. Pieces in this collection include the lively dance, "A Pirate's Jig," the eerie and mysterious "The Ghost Ship," the stormy "Hurricane Hannah" and the delicate "Jewel of the Sea." It is my hope that these and other pieces in A Pirate's Life will spark the imagination and inspire the creativity of your students, and above all, help them to enjoy making music at the piano.


To the Student:








The Ghost Ship


