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## PROGRAM NOTES

*River Songs* was commissioned to commemorate the lives of two band members (one African-American and one white), who died within the span of a few years.

Two appropriate tunes were chosen to reflect each culture: the traditional Spiritual "Deep River," and Robert Lowry's beloved "Shall We Gather at the River."

The work begins with an expansive introduction and leads into the eighth note *river motif*, over which "Deep River" is first heard. After a brief passage of original material, the woodwinds introduce "Shall We Gather at the River" soaring above "Deep River" in the upper woodwinds, as witness to our common bonds in this life and beyond.
