TRANSIT OF VENUS

In it's travels around the sun, Venus sometimes comes directly between the earth and the sun. The track is seldom across the center of the sun but when it is, Venus takes about eight hours to cross. (Transits of Venus were observed in 1769 and 1874 and 1882). The next transits will occur on June 8, 2004 and June 6, 2012.

The TRANSIT OF VENUS march was first published in 1883. We are not sure that Sousa actually saw the two transits (he seemed intrigued by the title), and has a novel by the same name published in 1918.

TRANSIT OF VENUS

In zijn reis naar de zon, komt Venus soms precies tussen de aarde en de zon te staan. Zijn baan gaat seldom over het midden van de zon, maar als dat wel het geval is dan doet Venus er 8 uur over om er voorbij te komen. (Doorgangen van Venus werden in 1769 en 1874 waargenomen in 1874 en 1882). De volgende doorgangen zullen zijn op 8 Juni 2004 en 6 Juni 2012.

De TRANSIT OF VENUS mars werd voor het eerst gepubliceerd in 1883. Men is er niet zeker van dat Sousa daadwerkelijk beide doorgangen heeft gezien (hij schijnt gefascineerd te zijn door de titel), Sousa heeft zijn boek gepubliceerd in 1918, dezelfde naam gegeven.
