About the Piece

Mount Rushmore National Memorial is a magnificent granite sculpture of the heads of four famous Presidents and is located near Keystone, South Dakota. Each head is approximately 60 feet, and includes Presidents George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt, and Abraham Lincoln. Each of the four Presidents played a significant role in the development of our country, and musically they are depicted with bold sounds emanating from the brass and percussion. The music remains powerful from start to finish, and serves as a reminder of both the accomplishments of the Presidents, and the power of the sculptures.
