

A well-known concert pianist in Europe, this German born composer lived primarily in Berlin and Paris. Moszkowski was educated in Dresden and Berlin, and was a student of Kullak. He later taught at Kullak's music academy.

As a composer, Moszkowski is best known for his piano compositions, but also has orchestral and chamber music to his credit. Moszkowski did compose one opera, no longer performed; however, his ballet music is still programmed.
