THE WORK: The eleven chorale preludes for Organ which comprise Johannes Brahms' opus 122 were written one year before his death and are among the last of his published works. SCHMUCKE DICH, O LIEBE SEELE is the fifth in this group. His admiration for and homage to J.S. Bach is quite evident here, and yet the music is still uniquely Brahmsian. This piece translates extremely well for low brass trio, especially when played in a thoughtful and intimate manner.
