NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Rehearse the March in 4 and gradually work up to a march tempo that is comfortable for your ensemble. May I suggest that the violins and violas in measures 1 and 2 start with an open D and place the 2nd finger on A, and the 1st finger on G# on the G string. The hi 3 fingerings are approached and left easily (ex. measures 12 and 13, 2nd violin). The bowings are suggested to help with the phrasing.
