Andrea Gabrieli (1520-1586) was an organist at St. Mark's cathedral in Venice who studied with the Flemish master Adriano Willaert in his youth and was a colleague at St. Mark's of Claudio Merulo. Gabrieli was a very prolific composer and also an extremely influential one; he was an inventive musician who searched for new Italian alternatives to the Flemish models of his time and paved the way for the superb works of his nephew, Giovanni Gabrieli. His students include, in addition to his nephew, Hans Leo Hassler and Gregor Aichinger, among others.
