RINGTONE CHRISTMAS

Ringtone Christmas came about after years of asking audience members before a performance to "please silence your cell phones". Every so often a rogue cell phone will ring during a performance. Naturally we roll with the punches because let's face it (stuff happens) and one little ringtone won't ruin a performance. I then had a dream about what it would be like if a perfect storm of ringers went off during a performance. Band kids are awesome, so of course they would take the minor inconvenience in stride and continue on with that time-honored saying "The show must go on!", and even make the ringtones part of their performance! Ringtone Christmas is a theatrical envisioning of that thought.

NOTES TO THE PERFORMERS

This piece uses audience participation (or sound drops) to create a holiday concert theatrical performance! Using cell phones in the audience, reenact my whacky dream of a perfect storm of ringtones going off at inopportune moments in the music. Eventually realise that "Stuff Happens" and rip and roar to the end with all the gusto of a broadway finale! Have fun, and go over the top and your audience will have a blast! PERFORMANCE INSTRUCTIONS

In order to play this piece, you will need to have a little instruction time for your audience. Try something like this: "Good evening parents, family and friends, for this next piece we will need your help. Take out your cell phone, open your settings and find your sounds and ringtones. Taking just 30 seconds and find a generic ringtone sound that you like. When prompted by myself, a student, or a helper during the piece, you will hit that ringtone once or until myself, a student, or a helper directs you to stop. Let's try it now". After you are comfortable that your audience has the ringtones, you can begin your performance. Have a merry time!

Remind the audience that they might hear things in the performance that contradict them using their cellphones (See Marking [B] for example). They should ignore those directions and instead follow the designated direction giver along with the directions given before the performance started.

SCRIPT

Marking [A]

- · At the first fermata
 - A student's phone in the band rings
- · At the second fermata
 - The student answers the phone "Hello"
- At the third fermata
 - Teacher responds: "Young _____, put that cellphone away"

Marking [B]

- At the first fermata:
 - · Cue the audience to play their ringtones
- At the second fermata:
 - Teacher to the audience: "Remember to silence your cell phones please".

Marking [C]

- · Without stopping, cue the audience to start their ringtones
- Without stopping, cue the audience to stop, only this time wave them away with one hand with as much drama as you can muster behind your back!

Marking [D]

- At the first fermata:
 - · Cue the audience to start their ringtones, you will not stop them until the end of the piece.

(R)

- At the second fermata:
 - The whole band raises their arms in an "oh well" expression. The director counts them off into M. 46.

Marking [E]

- Before the fermata:
 - Band members shout "Hey" accusatorily and points at the audience.
- After the fermata:
 - The director counts off into M. 55

Marking [F]

- At the fermata:
 - Allow the audience's ringtones to fill the airspace for a moment then cue them off with the final note of your performance.
