

It's Party Time

For this activity you will need a bubble-blowing kit.

- The children sit in a circle and pass a beanbag or small toy round while they sing the song. (At * use one of the children's names if appropriate.)
- When the song stops the child with the beanbag has a chance to blow a bubble.
- Ask the other children to watch the bubble and make a quiet sound with their voices (e.g. mmmm or shhhh) all the time they can see it. This is a useful and 'fun' way to practise the sounds of different letters.
