Sifuni Leo (He's Born Today-O!) is a joyously energetic Christmas chorus adapted by Patrick M. Liebergen from a traditional African folksong. The traditional Swahili phrase, "Sifuni leo," means "praise today" and is pronounced see-FOO-nee LEH-oh. The call-and-response between the soloist and choir may be performed very effectively by placing the soloist across the room from the choir. Sifuni Leo may also be performed as a processional, in which the soloist sings from the front of the room as the choir enters from the rear or the sides.

The use of percussion accompaniment is optional but is highly recommended. Both a fully orchestrated percussion packet (triangle, woodblock, conga drums and bass drum), No. 18313, and a fully orchestrated performance/accompaniment track, No. 18306, are available separately.

**Sifuni Leo** is available in three voicings and is appropriate for performance by all ages of both school and church singers. When performed in church, suggested corresponding lectionary readings include Isaiah 7: 10-14. Matthew 1: 18-25 and Luke 2: 1-20.

Patrick M. Liebergen is Director of Choral Activities at the University of Wisconsin (Stout). With music degrees from St. Norbert College in DePere, Wisconsin, the University of Wisconsin (Madison), and the University of Colorado (Boulder), he frequently appears throughout the country as an adjudicator and clinician. Dr. Liebergen has received choral composition awards from the Twin Cities Church Musicians' Association and the Wisconsin Choral Directors' Association, and his works are widely published and performed.
