Preface

Autumn Colors: Easy Piano Pieces for Golden Days has been curated to capture the melancholic and vibrant atmosphere of autumn in accessible piano pieces. The works are simplified and reduced to their essence, allowing you to dive into the melodies without extensive practice. This collection is designed for both beginners and intermediate pianists seeking a quick entry into autumnal classics.

The collection opens with *Autumn Mood (Waltz No. 3)* by Paul Lincke, a lively waltz that captures the cheerful lightness of autumn with its golden hues. It is followed by *Little Adagio* from *The Seasons (Autumn)* by Alexander Glazunov, which, with its lyrical melody, reflects the quiet, contemplative mood of falling leaves.

After an autumnal stroll, Anton Bruckner's *Silent Contemplation on an Autumn Evening* (WAB 123) invites introspection. This short, poetic piano piece, presented in a compact and accessible simplified version, captures the profound calm of an autumn evening.

The journey continues with *October — Autumn Song* from *The Seasons* op. 37b by Pyotr Ilyich Tchaikovsky. This piece reflects the melancholic beauty of autumn and, with its captivating melody, invites you to dream as nature prepares for winter.

Concluding the collection is Robert Schumann's *Harvest Song* from *Album for the Young* op. 68, offering a joyful and carefree note. Originally composed for young pianists, this piece brings the delight of the harvest season to the piano and, in its simplified form, serves as a wonderful finale to the collection.

These pieces are perfect for trying out autumnal melodies without much practice. You can quickly put together an autumnal concert program to share with family and friends.

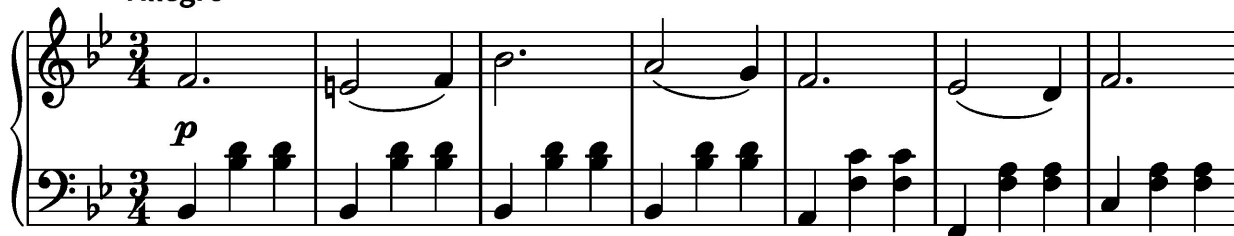

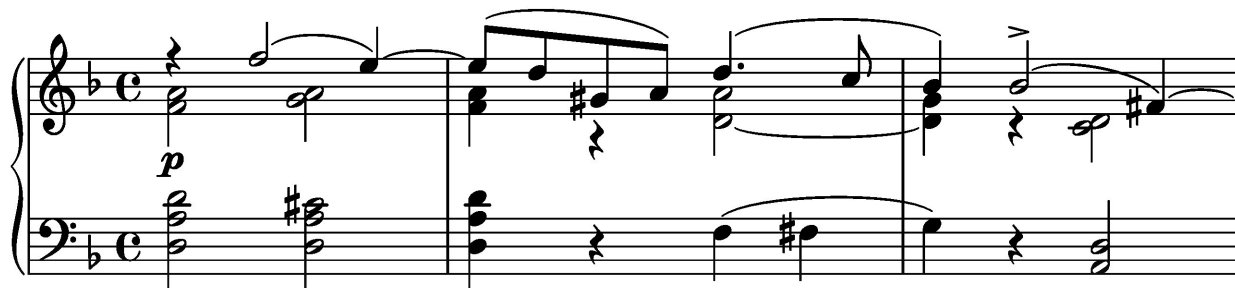
