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Paolo Baratto



Deutsch : Paolo Baratto wurde am 30. Januar 1926 in Untersiggenthal (Aargau/Schweiz) geboren, und lebt zur Zeit In Rümlang (ZH).

Paolo Baratto erhielt schon mit sieben Jahren Trompetenunterricht. Er studierte am Konservatorium Zürich und begann eine vielseitige Karriere als Solotrompeter, Blasmusikleiter und Komponist.

Zwischen 1943 und 1961 spielte er oft auch im Festspielorchester der Internationalen Musikfestwochen in Luzern mit. Paolo Baratto war von 1943-1953 Solotrompeter im Orchester Radio Svizzera Italiana in Lugano. Ab 1954 bis 1984 war er Mitglied des Tonhalle-Orchesters Zürich. Er fühlte sich immer mit der Blasmusik verbunden, leitete verschiedene Blasmusikvereine, u.a. einige Jahre die Stadtmusik Baden AG.

Von 1975 bis 1997 hat Paolo Baratto ein Dutzend Märsche bzw. Marschlieder geschrieben, im weiteren 160 Kompositionen verschiedenster Gattungen, viele Solostücke für Trompete(n) und Orgel/Klavier, eine *Serenade* für Trompete und Euphonium mit Klavier oder Brass Band (1997), ein *Concerto* für Horn und Streichorchester, ein *Brassquintett*, ein *Divertimento* für Klarinette, Horn und Klavier usw...

English : Paolo Baratto was born in 1926 in Untersiggenthal in Switzerland. He now lives in Rümlang in the canton of Zürich.

Paolo Baratto had his first trumpet lessons at the age of seven, later studying at Zürich Conservatoire. He has had a successful career as a solo trumpet player, wind band conductor and composer. From 1943-1961 he regularly played in the Lucerne Festival Orchestra. From 1943-1953 he was 1st trumpet in the Radio Orchestra in Lugano, and from 1954 to 1984 he was a member of the Tonhalle Orchestra in Zürich. He has always had an affinity with the wind band world, and conducted several ensembles, including the Stadtmusik in Baden.

From 1975-1997 he composed a dozen marches and 160 other compositions for various formations including solo pieces for trumpet and organ or piano, a Serenade for trumpet and euphonium with piano or brass band (1997), a concerto for horn and strings, a brass quintet, a Divertimento for clarinet, horn and piano and much else.

Français : Paolo Baratto naquit en 1926 à Untersiggenthal en Suisse. Il habite actuellement à Rümlang dans le canton de Zürich.

Paolo Baratto reçu des leçons de trompette dès l'âge de sept ans et fit ses études au Conservatoire de Zürich.

Il entama ensuite une activité polyvalente en tant que trompettiste soliste, directeur d'harmonie et compositeur.

Entre 1943 et 1961 il participa régulièrement à l'Orchestre du Festival de Lucerne. De 1943-1953 il fut première trompette solo de l'Orchestre de la Radio Suisse Italienne à Lugano, et de 1954-1984 membre de l'Orchestre de la Tonhalle à Zürich.

Il a toujours été attiré par le monde des orchestres à vent, et a dirigé plusieurs ensembles, entre autres la Stadtmusik de Baden.

Entre 1975 et 1997 il composa une douzaine de marches et 160 autres compositions pour diverses formations, y compris de nombreuses pièces pour trompette et piano ou orgue, une Sérénade pour trompette et euphonium avec piano ou brass band (1997), un concerto pour cor et orchestre à cordes, un quintette de cuivres, un Divertimento pour clarinette, cor et piano, etc.
