Performance notes

- The upper manual (II) sounds slightly lighter than the lower manual (I)
- *Legato*: play the successive notes very connected
- *Legatissimo*: keep the notes down as long as possible
- Play in general with expression (*rubato* on the first beat)
- The sign ——— on top of the system indicates that *espressivo* is prescribed
- *Deciso*: play rhythm very precise
- Appoggiaturas on the beat and as short as possible

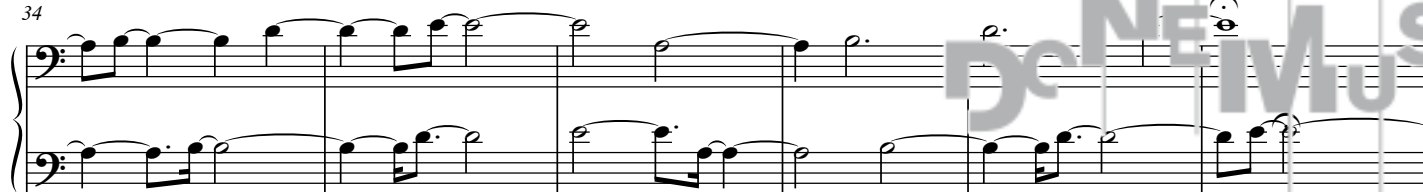

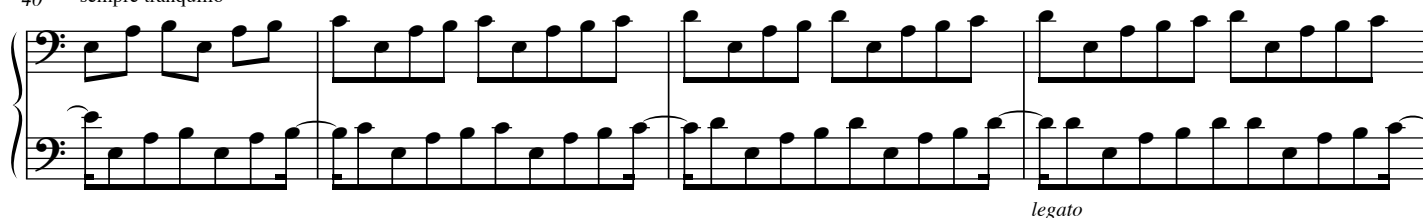
