James Burton

James Burton (b. 1974) is a graduate of the Peabody Conservatory and Cambridge University. Alongside a flourishing conducting career, as a composer he has been commissioned by the Boston Symphony Orchestra, the Hallé Concerts Society, the Choir of St John's College, Cambridge, the National Portrait Gallery, the Exon Festival and the Clothworkers' Company. His work *The Lost Words* (2019) was premiered at the Tanglewood Festival and has been featured at the BBC Proms and performed by the Royal Scottish National Orchestra. His choral works have been performed, broadcast and recorded by many ensembles including the BBC Singers, The Sixteen and the King's Singers.

James Burton (*1974) ist Absolvent des Peabody Conservatory und der Cambridge University. Neben seiner erfolgreichen Karriere als Dirigent erhielt er Kompositionsaufträge vom Boston Symphony Orchestra, von der Hallé Concerts Society, dem Chor des St John's College, Cambridge, der National Portrait Gallery, dem Exon Festival und der Clothworkers' Company. Sein Werk *The Lost Words* (2019) wurde beim Tanglewood Festival uraufgeführt und bei den BBC Proms vom Royal Scottish National Orchestra gespielt. Seine Chorwerke wurden von vielen Ensembles aufgeführt, aufgenommen und ausgestrahlt, darunter die BBC Singers, The Sixteen und die King's Singers.
