PROGRAM NOTES

This lullaby is one of those traditional songs that has been handed down from generation to generation as mothers have used it to convey love, warmth, and peace to their children at bedtime. Originally from Spain, and famous throughout Latin America, this folk song has remained melodically intact, although in some countries the lyrics have been altered a bit. This arrangement is a new rendition based on the arranger's recollection of the melody when growing up in Cuba.

The Green Intermediate series includes appropriately placed bowings for middle-level students. Fingerings and positions are marked for notes beyond first position. The Blue Concert series includes bowings appropriate for the experienced high school player. Fingerings and position markings are indicated for difficult passages.
