Tuning Your Guitar






Notes on the Fourth String


A note on the lowest space of the staff is called F. You already know F on the 1st string. This F is on the 4th string and sounds lower than F on the 1st string. To play this note, use finger 3 to press the 4th string at the 3rd fret. Pick only the 4th string.














Baseball
