Reverie

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Reverie is a lyrical piece reflecting someone in a dream-like state. It is a peaceful song using repetitive melodic figures, lush harmonies, and simple rhythms.

As with all lyrical piece, balance is key. The chorale-like style is important to embellish the beauty and peacefulness of the piece, but should never be dominant.

When working through this piece, it is important to focus on strong air support and gentle articulations, allowing players to perform rhythmic figures without changing the legato effect of the piece.

Dynamic swells, such as those in the opening measures, can be performed with as much dramatic effect as the ensemble chooses; just be sure that any melodic material can be heard.

Finally, after the piece thins out at measure 39, be sure that measure 43 isn't too overpowering when all instruments enter. Try to make it gentle, yet dramatic, building into the final measures of the piece.

Ryan Meeboer is a music educator, who obtained his degree through the Ontario Institute for Studies in Education at the University of Toronto. As a composer, he has written and arranged many pieces for concert band, jazz band, and small ensembles. Ryan began studying music at the age of seven through private guitar lessons. During his years in elementary and secondary school, he gained experience in several families of instruments. Focusing on music education and theory (including composition and orchestration), he attended McMaster University to achieve his honours degree in music. Ryan is currently a teacher for the Halton District School Board in Ontario, where he continues to compose and arrange.
