Sonate a Sei Voci

Giovanni Battista Buonamente

Arranged by Don Sweete

Giovanni Battista Buonamente was a composer of the early Baroque era in Italy. He worked in Assisi, and died there in 1643. The sonata presented here was originally published in 1636, with a specified instrumentation of two Cornettos and four Sackbuts (or alternatively, strings) plus Continuo. This modern edition, placed in the original key, is scored for two Trumpets in C, Alto Trombone, two Tenor Trombones and Bass Trombone, with Organ. Suggested dynamics have been added by the editor.
