GET READY TO PLAY

STAFF A Staff has five lines and four spaces. **CLEF SIGN** A clef sign is a symbol placed on the staff. The first seven letters of the alphabet ABCDEFGABCDEFG are used in music to name the lines and spaces. Names of the Lines and Spaces. **BAR LINE AND MEASURE** bar lines A bar line is a line drawn through the staff. A measure is the distance between two bar lines. – measure -FINAL BAR LINE A final bar line has a thin bar line and a thick bar line which indicates the end. TIME SIGNATURE A time signature is placed at the beginning of the staff and indicates the number of counts in a measure. There are four counts in four/four time. **NOTE** The parts of a note. Note heads flag stem **ACCIDENTALS** Flats, Sharps, and Naturals are called accidentals. Whole Note Receives four counts of sound in 4/4 time. Whole Rest Receives four counts of silence in 4/4 time.
