### Naomi Rebecca Hill



Naomi Rebecca Hill was born in 2002 in The United Kingdom, in the North of England in West Yorkshire. Growing up in The Salvation Army, Naomi has been surrounded by musical influences from a very young age; it is from here where her passion for music is rooted and where her brass playing, and composing began. This influence, particularly as a composer, continues to remain an important part of her work and musical identity. Naomi is a Baritone and Euphonium player, composer and arranger and as a music student she has studied performance, conducting, musicological research and composition at The University of Huddersfield, graduating with a First-Class Honours BMus Music degree and the University Brass Prize in 2023.

She is now pursuing postgraduate level study undertaking a Masters in Performance at The University of Huddersfield. Surrounded by a rich heritage of brass bands, situated in Yorkshire, Naomi performs regularly with brass bands, sometimes as a soloist and also enjoys performing with other ensembles such as symphonic wind orchestras and chamber groups on both the Euphonium and Baritone Horn.

For Naomi performance comes hand in hand with composition and these aspects of her musicianship greatly influence one another. Her musical roles within her Salvation Army church, at university and in ensembles more widely and also her keen interest in teaching and leading young instrumentalists also all interlink and continue to expand upon Naomi's existing passions and outlets.

As a composer Naomi writes for various instrument combinations and ensembles, but she particularly finds fulfilment in composing and arranging for brass, exploring the diverse tonal qualities and nuances of brass instruments, and exploring these in her experimentation of different harmonic colours.

Her focus on harmony is often a key area of exploration for her as a composer - this underpins the continuing development of her own personal compositional style. In recent years Naomi's composition output has increased and her music has been performed, programmed in a brass band entertainment contest, and recorded on occasions by ensembles. She has also received composition prizes – she was shortlisted as a finalist for the A4 Brass Quartet Composition Competition in 2022 and awarded the Under 24 Award.

Most recently Naomi received first prize in Foden's Band Female Composer Competition in 2023 with a 6-minute original work for brass band. She also received a commission to compose a short piece for brass ensemble as part of 'Kirklees Year of Music 2023' which was recorded by a brass ensemble and the track later released.

Naomi's composing, like her performing, covers a range of genres and ensemble types from chamber groups, choral, piano, brass and wind, and brass bands. Through her varied areas of work as a music graduate, she is particularly passionate about drawing emphasis to the way music can transform and unite society, and also aid communication, nurture individuals and cultivate creativity in a way that is unique, and this holds intrinsic value to society and is an important aspect to Naomi's musicianship.
