Performance Options:

1. One verse and scripture each of the Sundays of Advent — This anthem may be sung to accompany the liturgical ritual action of lighting the Advent candles. In order to do this, sing the appropriate verse and recite the appropriate scripture each of the four Sundays of the Advent season. The “optional repeat” (measure 15) may be observed (or not) depending on time constraints. Encourage the congregation to sing along, if so desired.

2. All verses and one scripture — Observing the “optional repeat” (measure 15), the first three verses may be sung, after which the chosen scripture may be recited while “ending 2” (measure 17) is observed. Finally, the fourth verse is sung at measure 23.

3. Choosing the ending — Two endings are provided, one in F minor, the other in F Major. If sung each of the four Sundays of Advent, one might consider the F minor ending for Sundays I–III, and the F major ending on Sunday IV, as the F-major ending implies more resolve and finality.
