




















Michael Story

Michael Story has written extensively for college, high school and junior high school bands, as well as for professional groups including the Houston Pops Orchestra. A versatile writer and current marching band editor for Alfred Music, he is adept at focusing on the needs of the developing band. His works for young or inexperienced concert and marching bands, such as his Big and Easy marching band series, is designed to accommodate uneven instrumentation while maintaining a full band sound.

Michael holds bachelor's and master's degrees in music education from the University of Houston, where he has served as an assistant band director. He works regularly with school bands in Texas and presents band workshops throughout the country

Michael is a solid and dynamic writer with more than 750 compositions published for bands and jazz ensemble. He is one of the major young driving forces among the writers and clinicians of Alfred Music.









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
