THE BAND AWARDS SYSTEM TIME LINE

Student progress through the B.A.S. will be determined by a number of factors including; frequency of lessons, number of students, student motivation and in a large part by the performance standards that you enforce. This time line represents the expected rate of progress based on laboratory studies taking place in several school systems and makes the assumption that your beginners are in fifth grade.
