Fast 6/8

When a piece in $\frac{6}{8}$ moves quickly, the conductor will beat $\underline{2}$ beats in every measure rather than $\underline{6}$. This is known as FAST $\frac{6}{8}$. The player should count $\underline{2}$ counts in every measure rather than $\underline{6}$.
