Dynamics and articulation are very important parts of learning to play musically. Since the notes and rhythms are easy, have the students pay attention to these directions and play as musically as possible. Harmonically, this is not what you will usually hear with beginning bands. The composition begins in a minor mode, going to its relative major, and returning back to the original melody and minor mode. Enjoy!
