

Hail the Conquering Hero

George Frederic Handel

In the shadow of the glory of *Messiah* from the pen George Frederic Handel (1685-1759) came *Judas Maccabaeus*. This was an oratorio written in 1746, inspired by the English victory at Culloden.

This version of the famous *Hail the Conquering Hero* opens with a solo cornet, gradually adds voices and builds in dynamic, then the sound drops to a solo tuba and begins again to grow to a stirring climax.

Flexible Junior Brass Band Series

This series allows the maximum in flexibility for developing brass musicians in the British Brass Band tradition. Each composition or arrangement has 6-7 unique parts with various percussion. Each part has several different transposition options. This allows for performance with as few players as 6 or performance by a full band instrumentation. There are also bass clef parts provided for the trombones, baritones, euphoniums and tubas for those players coming from a concert band tradition that are not yet comfortable reading treble clef. The range, endurance and technical demands are all carefully considered when writing for less experienced players.
