THE WORK: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) wrote over 300 cantata's. This is the most famous section from Cantata No. 208. One of the most famous pieces of all time, Sheep May Safely Graze has been arranged for every possible combination of instruments including solo organ, full orchestra, classical guitar and even steel drums.

THE TRANSCRIPTION: The flutes should play with the piano and not against it. The flutes should always attempt to blend in with the piano sound, whether they are playing the choral melody or the eighth-sixteenth passages.
