INFINITY PERCUSSION is an affiliate of Pageantry Arts Concepts, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. As a PAC affiliate, our goal is to provide youth and young adults the opportunity to enhance their performance and musical skills while furthering their knowledge of the marching arts activity in a professional setting.

PROGRAM NOTE

Burning the Candle at Both Ends is a percussion ensemble piece that explores the concept of sonic texture and spatial audio—composed for a unique ensemble consisting of seven concert snare drums and piano, offering an immersive auditory experience for both performers and listeners allke and is dedicated to Robert W. Smith.

Mike Hansen shares this memory

"The first time I sat down with Robert to discuss composing for RWS was in 2022, at a dinner with his wife Susan Smith, daughter Madison Smith, composer Mitchell Beckman, and Infinity Percussion Founder John Campese. Robert asked a question that evening that I was hesitant to answer... "What is it that you enjoy about arranging for percussion?"

The answer I gave was, "I'm less interested in the rudimental aspects of percussion and more driven by the opportunity to paint with sonic textures." I was hesitant to share this because, in my experience, not having the rudimental side of percussion as the primary focus seemed to be labeled as unorthodox or of lesser value.

Robert stopped me, looked at John, and said "You taught this guy?" John nodded yes. Robert looked back at me, "This is the guy we need." Robert saw value in that mindset and empowered us with an opportunity to share it.



NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

This percussion ensemble can be performed in a variety of configurations. Configuration 1: Plano in center, framed by a semi-circle of the seven concert snares. (This setup caters to a L-R panning effect) Configuration 2: Plano in the center, with 7 concert snare drums in front in a semi-circle or randomly placed around the room. (This setup caters to an immersive spatial audio effect.) We suggest that the distance between each snare drum is a minimum of 3 feet and a maximum of 6 feet. If the program does not have access to 7 of the same concert snares, any combination of available drums will suffice and create a new and unique interpretation of this piece. Suggested concert snare tuning: "C" on the batter head and "F" on the snare side head.
