Antonio Vivaldi was a renowned composer and violin virtuoso in Venice, Italy during the Baroque era. Besides completing over 400 concertos, including the famous *Le Quattro Station (The Four Seasons)*, he also wrote chamber works, operas, and a variety of sacred choral works. "Rise Up With Music" is from his opera *La Fida Ninfa* which Vivaldi completed in 1732 for the opening of the new Teatro Filarmonico in Verona. This pastoral opera in three acts features six characters who have many misunderstandings in their relationships. The chorus featured here is a joyful and triumphant song at the end of the third act. Originally scored for S.A.T.B. voices and two soloists with an accompaniment of trumpets, timpani, strings, and continuo, this arrangement includes a piano reduction of the instrumental parts.
