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Foreword

Romantic Reveries has been compiled with the greatest care to capture the tender magic of love and longing in piano pieces that are easy to play. Each work has been thoughtfully simplified and reduced to its pure musical essence, allowing you to dive straight into the melodies without demanding advanced technique and to enjoy the gentle poetry of these compositions at the piano.

This collection is aimed at beginners as much as at pianists with just a few years of experience. It contains five immortal gems of the Romantic era:

Franz Liszt's **Liebestraum** – Notturno No. 3, S. 541/3, one of the most touching declarations of love in all piano literature, flowing in soft waves; Claude Debussy's **Clair de lune** from the Suite bergamasque, L. 75, which caresses the soul with shimmering moonlight; Frédéric Chopin's **Nocturne** Op. 9 No. 2, a song full of intimacy and tender longing; Franz Schubert's **Serenade** (Ständchen), D. 957 No. 4, an ardent plea for love that goes straight to the heart; and Robert Schumann's **Dreaming** (Träumerei) from Scenes from Childhood, Op. 15 – that small miracle that holds both childhood dreams and adult emotions in perfect balance.

These five pieces embody the very essence of romantic moments and are ideal for playing heartfelt melodies with little practice. They can also be effortlessly combined into a short, intimate programme for special occasions or evenings for two.

Thanks to their clarity and simplicity, this collection will quickly bring you joy and make it easy to work your way into the pieces. Perhaps it will even awaken the desire to one day explore the original versions, which are also published in the Classicato series. Let this edition inspire you to bring love, longing and tender feelings to life with your own hands. May the music accompany you in your dreamy hours and











Nocturne in E-flat major
