The Irish spirit is a direct reflection of the unique place on earth that is their native land. The rugged landscape speaks of staunch individualism, while the more idyllic settings suggest a deep love of nature and the beauty found in all. IRISH SUITE presents three folk tunes that embody these characteristics: "The Wearing of the Green," "I Know Where I'm Going," and "I Wish I Had the Shepherd's Lamb."

- I. "The Wearing of the Green" Attributed to Dublin resident Dion Boucicault (1820-1890), the text brings to mind a deep pride in country and culture, as well as a battle cry of sorts for independence over British domination at that time in Ireland's history.
- II. "I Know Where I'm Going" From County Antrim in Northern Ireland comes this touching ballad that spans only five notes: I know where I'm going and I know who's going with me. I know who I'll love, but who knows who I'll marry.
- III. "I Wish I Had the Shepherd's Lamb" Also from County Antrim, the original text is in the authentic Gaelic tongue, while the melody, as is often the case, has been adapted from a popular dance tune of the day: I wish I had the shepherd's lamb, the shepherd's lamb, the shepherd's lamb, I wish I had the shepherd's lamb and Katey coming after.

#### NOTE FROM THE EDITOR

All Belwin string parts have been carefully bowed and fingered appropriately by level. The Yellow Very Beginning series includes many bowings as well as reminder fingerings for first-time readers. The Red Beginning series includes frequent bowings to assist younger players. Fingerings for altered pitches are often marked. The Green Intermediate series includes appropriately placed bowings for middle-level students. Fingerings and positions are marked for notes beyond first position. The Blue Concert series includes bowings appropriate for the experienced high school player. Fingerings and position markings are indicated for difficult passages.
